* CALL TO WORSHIP

Liturgist: I love the Lord,

All: for he heard my voice, he heard my cry for mercy.

Liturgist: The Lord turned his ear to me,

All: I will call on him as long as I live.

Liturgist: The cords of death entangled me, and the anguish of the grave overcame me; I was overcome by distress and sorrow.

All: Then I called on the name of the Lord: "Lord, save me!"

Liturgist: The Lord is gracious and righteous; our God is full of compassion.

All: The Lord protects the unwary; when I was brought low he saved me.

Silent Reflection and Confession

All Singing: 460 "Our Eyes Are Turned"

Repeating, following the lead of the leaders

Liturgist: Since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

All: through whom we have gained access by faith into the grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God.

Liturgist: You see, just at the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly.

All: For God demonstrated his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Liturgist: Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him!

All: For if, while we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life!

Liturgist: What shall I return to the Lord for all his goodness to me?

All: I will lift up the cup of salvation and call on the name of the Lord.

Liturgist: I will sacrifice a thank offering to you and call on the name of the Lord. I will fulfill my vows to the Lord in the presence of all his people, in the courts of the house of the Lord –

All: Praise the Lord.
